Mayor Patrick Miller informed the council that the Park Board decided to defer this decision to the Board of Aldermen. Discussion was held about the best way to refurbish one of the last original playground items in the park. Mayor Patrick Miller recommended that the merry-go-round be taken to an auto body shop to be sand blasted, primed and painted. Alderman Todd Williams discussed what types of primer should be used to ensure the longevity of the paint.

Mayor Patrick Miller informed the council that Electrical worker Kenny Robertson had provided a rough estimate of \$58,000 to replace the Memorial Park ballfield lights, underground wiring and poles. Discussion held about the asset that the parks are to the City and the need/desire to support improvements. Alderman Todd Williams asked that Electrical worker Kenny Robertson get prices on replacing the globe lights as well. The city auditor is to be contacted concerning the possibility of the electric fund to manage and provide new lighting for the ballfields and drive thru.

Request made to Peopleservice / connect to city sewer system Mayor Patrick Miller told the council that George Hulet, Peopleservice had received a request from a citizen about connecting to the city sewer system on a proposed building that will be outside the city limits. Mayor Patrick Miller was assured by Mr. Hulet that there would not be any capacity issues. The citizens will be attending the next meeting.

Mayor Patrick Miller asked for council reports.

Request Given / Progress Report on Junked up Properties Alderman Todd Williams asked about his previous request for a progress report on clean-up of junk on properties from Jacob Doll, Code Enforcement. Mayor Patrick Miller asked if Alderman Todd Williams would like to have Mr. Doll at the next meeting. Alderman Todd Williams responded affirmatively.

Deductible Health Insurance Issues Alderman Todd Williams asked if anything had been resolved concerning the employee deductible on the health insurance. Mayor Patrick Miller responded that there has not been a solution to this issue and they are in the process of bidding for health insurance now.

Issues with Recyclable Items Alderman Todd Williams asked if the recycling issue with Porters had been addressed. Mayor Patrick Miller explained that since Administrator Janelle Hagler is absent, he did not have an answer. Mayor Patrick Miller offered to call Porter Trash concerning this issue.

Request made for electric prices on 3 ballfields Alderman Todd Williams expressed that he wants Electric worker Kenny Robertson to get prices on all three ballfields and the drive thru lights.

Ordinance to be ready on Concealed Carry – next meeting Mayor Patrick Miller asked City Attorney Cristine Stallings if she would be able to have the ordinance on concealed carry at the next meeting. City Attorney Stallings agreed that the ordinance would be ready for presentation at the next regular meeting.

Budget Session Mayor Patrick Miller started the budget session at 6:10 p.m. City Attorney Stallings left the meeting.

The Council discussed budget on Electric, Gas, Water, Sewer, Street, Motor Pool, Sales Tax, and General Funds. The utility projects and rates were discussed as well as street projects, street bond dollars, and sales tax revenues.

The next special budget meeting set for March 14, 2016.
