Public Input

Discussion Held / Completion of 39th Street and Residential Street Improvements

Charles Crabtree, city resident, asked Council why the street bond money was being used to complete 39th Street. Randy Brejnik and Gene Ishmael also commented on the use of the bond money being used on 39th Street. Randy Brejnik asked if the street could stay a gravel road and do more streets. Mayor Patrick Miller said that the Street Department does not have time to complete anymore projects this year and if more streets are constructed it will have to be contracted. Alderman Steve Miles said 39th Street needs to be completed so it will open up land for future development and there has been interest in building on that road. Charles Crabtree believes that is speculation and the money needs to be used on the regular streets. Attorney Cristine Stallings said that in the zoning code the city can accept a gravel road. Mayor Patrick Miller said that no money will be spent on 39th Street addition until it passes the City Code. Charles Crabtree asked if the city still has a TIF attorney at this time. The spending of the South TIF was also discussed.

George Hulet, PeopleService, submitted bids for manhole and valve box risers for asphalt overlay project. The bids submitted were H.D. Administrator Janelle Hagler told council that since Porter Trash has been picking up everything on a weekly basis, this spring cleanup will be advertised as the last city-wide cleanup. Complaints on the recycle bin getting full were discussed with Porter Trash.

Administrator Janelle Hagler talked with Paul Gard, Motor Pool, about the hours that were credited to the council. Paul Gard's hours that were credited to council were for cleaning up and showing the vehicles for the sale. The new car has only ten hours of shop maintenance time.
