Discussion on No Parking Along Beekman St

Alderman Todd Williams asked about the issue of no parking along Beekman Street by the Elementary School that was discussed by SHHS Superintendent Dennis Eastin. Administrator Janelle Hagler will send SHHS a letter about putting up the no parking signs up so the School Board develop a plan in place for alternative parking.

Alderman Todd Williams asked Administrator Janelle Hagler if Jacob Denum, Fire Chief, was aware of the billing for out of town rates for the fire calls. Administrator Janelle Hagler will discuss this issue with Fire Chief Denum.

Discussed Hubbard Street In Need Of Repair

Alderman Steve Miles told Administrator Janelle Hagler that Hubbard Street was really bad. The street has really big holes and the sides are breaking off. Administrator Janelle Hagler will notify the Street Department to look into the issue.

Discussion Held / Street Sales Tax

The Council discussed whether they wanted to have the street sales tax to run again. Only scheduled election in 2015 is in April. The Council feels that people were unaware that the sales tax portion of the November 2014 ballot was needed to pay for the bond. Administrator Janelle Hagler will have information at the next meeting from Gilmore & Bell on new ballot language. Ballot must be submitted to the County Clerk by January 27th to be on the April 7th ballot.

Mayor Correspondence Or Appointments

Mayor Patrick Miller correspondence or appointments.

Mayor Patrick Miller told Council that City Treasurer Becky Turley, Administrator Janelle Hagler, and Mayor Patrick Miller are working on the budget. Alderman Todd Williams would like the Council to think about hiring a carpenter. The city has several jobs that would keep a carpenter busy instead of bidding out the jobs. Budget meetings will begin as early as the next meeting.
