IMPORTANT NOTICE

The undersigned, being the owner or occupier of land located within the City of Bethany, hereby makes application to the City for utilities and agrees to the following conditions, subject to change by the Bethany Board of Aldermen:

1. The undersigned agrees to be responsible for payment of utility service at the address requested above and that he or she or any other residents of the home are not, at the time of signing in arrears to the City for past due or delinquent utility bills.
2. The undersigned shall remit payment on or before the fifteenth of each month for the prior month's bill. Bills not paid by the 15th shall be subject to a 7.5% penalty.
3. Bills not paid by 8 a.m. on the 4th Wednesday of each month will result in disconnection of utilities. A reconnection fee in the amount of \$100 will be required prior to reconnection as a result of nonpayment. An additional \$30 dollars will be due if reconnection is required after 5 p.m. on weekdays or anytime on weekends and holidays. Once utility service has been disconnected per the terms of this paragraph, a new application for service may be requested before service is restored.
4. The undersigned hereby states that all information provided as set forth in this application for services is true and complete. The undersigned understands that one or more false statements on this application for services shall be considered sufficient cause to immediately terminate all utility services without any notice to the Customer whatsoever. The City is hereby authorized to make any investigation of the undersigned's financial and credit records through any investigative or credit agencies, bureaus, or other methods. The undersigned understands that if any person with a past due utility account is residing at the premises herein described at any point in time, all utility services may, at the sole discretion of the City be immediately disconnected at any time without notice to the Customer.
5. The service supplied by the City shall be for the sole use of the undersigned; the undersigned agrees that he/she will not extend or permit the extension of pipes or other apparatus for the purpose of transferring water or other utilities from one property to another, nor will he/she share, resell, or sub-meter water or any other utility service to any other consumer.
6. The laws of the State of Missouri, ordinances of the City of Bethany and Rules and Regulations of the City, as presently existing and as may be amended from time to time are made a part of this agreement as though fully set forth herein.
7. The undersigned agrees that he/she will grant to the City, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement, in, over, and upon the premises covered by this agreement, with the right to erect, construct, install and lay and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace and remove utility lines and appurtenant facilities, together with the right to utilize adjoining lands belonging to User for the purpose of ingress and egress from the above-described land.
8. **DISCLAIMER.** The City shall not be responsible for the water service line as set forth in Bethany City Code Section 700.220, the gas fuel line from the gas meter (including all inside structure piping and appliances used in connection therewith, the sewer service line from the public sewer main and the electric service line as provided within the City's rules, regulations and policies.
13. User agrees that, in the event it is necessary for the City to pursue legal action to enforce the terms of this Agreement or collect a delinquent bill, the City shall be entitled to the costs of collection, including court costs, interest and attorneys' fees.
