Resolution 2020-01 Administrator Jake Taylor presented Resolution 2020-01 to withdraw from the Midwest Public Risk (MPR) effective June 30, 2020.

RESOLUTION 2020-01: TO WITHDRAW FROM THE MIDWEST PUBLIC RISK (MPR) EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2020, was read by Mayor Jonne Slemons.

Alderman Lance Johns asked if there was going to be issues with the employees out of pocket expense.

Administrator Jake Taylor said it would not affect the employees since the deductions run July 1 thru June 30.

Mayor Jonne Slemons voiced her concern that the resolution states 90 days notice will be given.

Administrator Jake Taylor said that he talked to MPR and it was agreed the letter notifying MPR that the City of Bethany was going out for bids would be considered notification.

Water/Sewer Project

Administrator Jake Taylor told the Council he recommends postponing the decision on the timber pump. The City has discovered an electric line will need to be installed prior to moving forward and PeopleService would like to talk to Grundy Electric concerning the issue.

PeopleService Sewer Project

Administrator Jake Taylor told the Council, PeopleService currently has its Sewer Department working on a project that is crossing Buck's Branch behind Hudlemeyer's property.

The Sewer Project will need to be engineered and Administrator Jake Taylor advised Howe Company can provide this service for \$20,000.00 which falls within the City budget. Once engineered, the City can get an estimate from Rodriguez who recently won the bid and do a change order to include it with the work they are already performing, or the second option is the City can go out for bids.

Mayor Jonne Slemons advised Council that it will cause issues again if it isn't fixed properly.

Motion made by Alderman Lance Johns to approve the engineering for the sewer line across Buck's Branch with Howe Company for \$20,000.00 and seconded by Alderman Randy Mann.
